### Special Statement

*\* Red Flag Warning from Noon to 9 PM \* Gusty southwest winds developing by midday along with very low afternoon humidity.*

### Fire

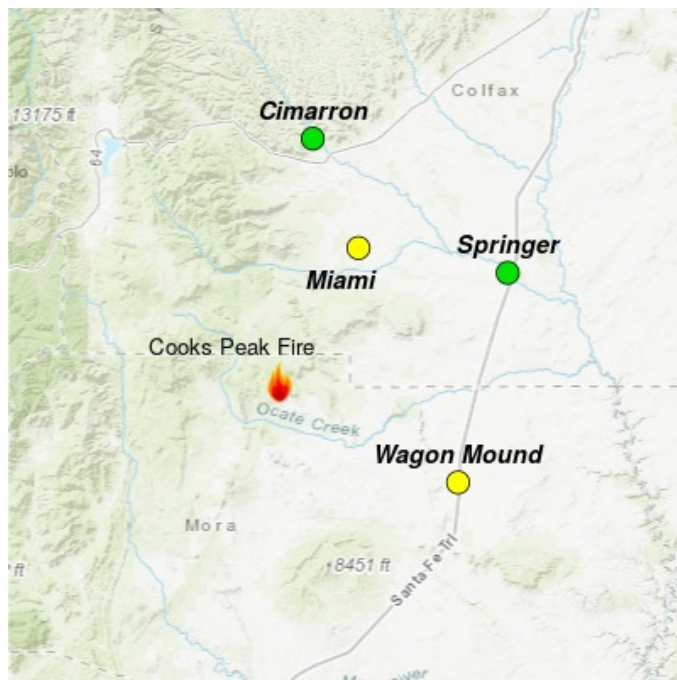
The Cooks Peak Fire is at 59,076 acres with 69% containment .

### Smoke

Minimal smoke impacts over the next couple days for due to favorable wind directions, and lack of activity on the Cooks Peak Fire. Smoke from regional fires will bring no worse than Moderate AQ to the area today. becoming Good on Wednesday as winds veer to the west.

### Road Conditions

Occasional blowing dust affecting the Interstate 25 areas from Wagon Mound to Springer, northward into this evening.
