

White River & Irving Peak Fires

The fire saw limited growth primarily on the northwest corner influenced by breezy conditions.

On the eastern edge, the fire crossed Ninemile Creek, but is currently holding in place.

A cold front moved into the area yesterday and brought gusty winds out of the northwest causing some interior burning and smoke throughout the fire.

The fire was most active in the southeast corner; however, the fire experienced minimal growth.

Today, firefighters will continue patrolling the southern portion of the fire while remaining ready for initial attack on any new fire starts.

The fire experienced low-to-moderate fire behavior with backing, flanking and short-range spotting. Containment lines on the southern flank continue to hold. Today, firefighters will continue to patrol and improve containment lines while also remaining prepared for new initial attack.
