



Today, resources will continue with structure protection in Eshom and Hartland.

Should the fire continue to spread north firefighters may conduct tactical firing operations along Generals Highway and within the Redwood Mountain Grove if conditions are favorable.

Firefighters on the eastern flank were able to extend containment lines north from the Lodgepole campground area.

Crews continue securing containment lines by extinguishing hotspots along the fireline and within the Giant Forest Grove.

Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) were utilized to gather information along the eastern perimeter near Middle Fork and south towards the Mineral King Rd.

Yesterday, the fire continued to back down towards North Fork Kaweah River until mid-afternoon when the fire spotted across the river.

The fire spotting across the river prompted Evacuation Orders for the community of Eshom, and Hartland.

Evacuation Warnings were also issued for the community of Badger in Tulare County Miramonte Fresno County.

Along the southern perimeter additional fire crews continued improving the Mineral King Rd. as a holding feature, while they scout for direct line opportunities.

On the western flank firefighters continue to secure isolated heat sources and maintain a presence in the communities of Three Rivers, and Ash Mountain.

Yesterday, evacuation orders were reduced to a warning for some residences in in the Mineral King and Three Rivers area.
