



Structure protection efforts continue for the communities of Eshom and Hartland.

Tactical firing operations continue along the northwest flank as conditions allow. Firefighters in Redwood Mountain Grove are working in coordination with resource advisors to establish plans for future tactical firing operations.

Minimal fire activity was observed near the northeast corner because the fire is burning in areas with less continuous fuels.

Tactical firing operations continue on the northwest corner of the fire.

Firefighters continue to secure and extinguish heat sources near established containment lines and within the Giant Forest Grove.

Firefighters are constructing fireline and patrol the areas around Three Rivers

Structure protection continues in Silver City and Mineral King.

Firefighters are assessing how to safely engage the spot fire across Mineral King Road. Structure protection continues for communities under evacuation orders. Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) are being used to help gather information along the southern perimeter.
