# **Fire**


The Windy Fire is now 88% contained with 97,554 acres. There are 1,101 personnel assigned. Yesterday, temperatures and higher humidity limited fire behavior. Today, gusty winds are expected along the eastern and southern portions of the fire, potentially increasing fire activity.

#### Smoke

Gusty winds will result in Good/Moderate air quality across the area. The Central Valley will experience blowing dust today impacting western locations in the forecast area, such as Porterville and Bakersfield. Briefly, during the midday hours, localized Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups levels are possible in the Valley. Residual smoke from the KNP Complex will filter through our region due to these northwesterly winds. Combined with the potential for increased fire activity, sheltered areas such as Tule River, and locations southeast of the fire will see highest smoke concentrations today. Tomorrow, as warming, drying, and a more stagnant pattern sets up, smoke concentrations are expected to increase across the area.

# **Blowing Dust Advisory**

The San Joaquin Air District recommends that residents in affected areas remain indoors with window and doors closed, avoiding exposure to blowing dust.
