Full toolbox: Prescribed Fire, mechanical, manual, chemical and seeding







#### **ENVIRONMENTAL FACTORS** AFFECTING FIRE BEHAVIOR: Topography Litter/forest type Litter/nitrogen volatilization to Seasonality atmosphere Fuel moisture Litter/nitrogen volatilization to atmosphere Heterogeneous litter/duff consumption Increased soil nutrient availability Soil protected by retained insulating litter layer


