
Fire

Hermits Peak Fire is currently at 7573 acres and 91% containment. Calf Canyon Fire: A new start on 04/19/2022 - approx. 245 acres.

Smoke

Smoke in the El Porvenir area will continue from the Calf Canyon Fire. Periods of Good to Moderate air quality. Winds out of the west southwest today. Light smoke activity in the area, but strong winds and blowing dust will impact the area.

Brief periods of reduced visibilities may be encountered along NM 518, especially during the evening and nighttime hours between Las Vegas, Sapello, and Storrie Lake SP due to smoke and blowing dust. Please exercise caution if traveling.
