Special Statement


RED FLAG WARNING A widespread damaging wind and extreme fire weather event developing after 10am and continuing into the evening. Southwest winds will sharply increase to 35-45 mph by midday into the afternoon. Widespread wind gusts of 60 to 70+ mph with the most intense surface winds expected with the passage of a Pacific cold front between 6-9pm.

Fire


Hermits Peak Fire is currently at 7573 acres and 91% containment. Calf Canyon Fire: - approx. 3000 acres.

Smoke

Smoke impacts in the area will occur in the late evening hours due to wind changes from the west. High winds and blowing dust will cause reduced visibility in areas on the roadways. Areas north of the fire will see smoke increasing in the area later in the day. Moderate to USG conditions will continue.
