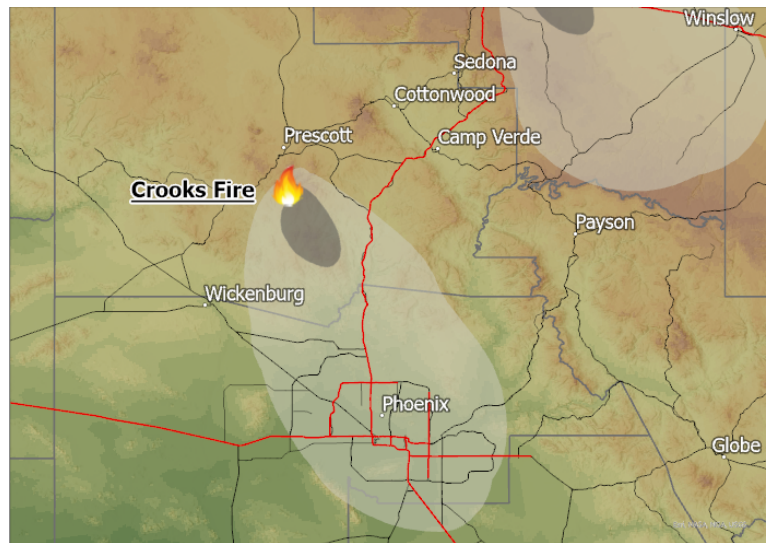


Smoke Synopsis

This morning smoke is noted moving toward the south, as the winds have shifted and are now out of the north. These north-northwest winds of 10-20mph will continue through the day into the overnight hours, meaning smoke will continue to move toward the south-southeast. Overall, light smoke impacts are expected today into tomorrow, with light smoke possible in the Crown King area. Smoke may move over the Phoenix Valley; however, not expecting any impact at ground level.

For Sunday, winds will continue to be 10-20mph but shift a bit more and be out of the north-northeast, so smoke will disperse toward the south-southwest, with smoke possibly moving overhead areas in/around Wickenburg, but again not expecting much impact at ground level.

The northerly breezes this weekend will also mean smoke is not likely to drain back into the Prescott Valley area, like we have seen the past few mornings, with only light haze expected during the early morning hours.
