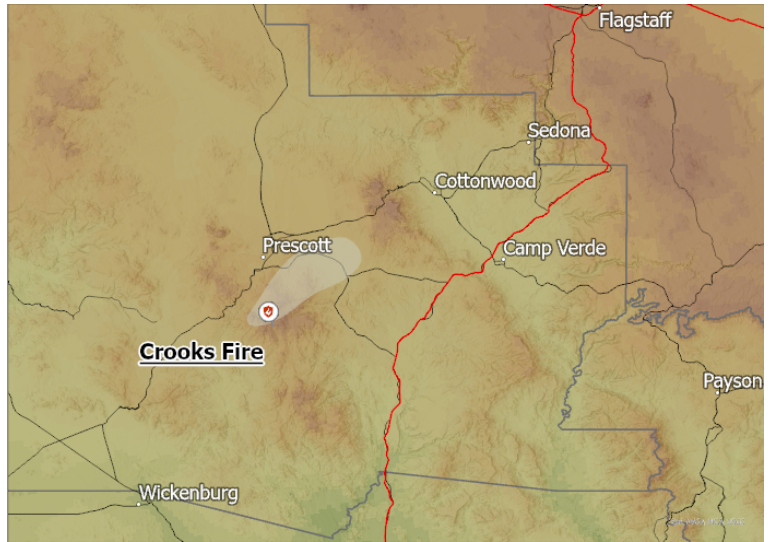


Smoke Synopsis

Only light smoke was noted on the Crooks Fire yesterday, and that trend is forecast to continue today as firefighters work tirelessly on the fire.

Strong southwest winds and continued dry conditions are forecast across the fire today, which may result in pockets of increased smoke production but overall, expecting the smoke that is produced to be light and move toward the northeast. Smoke may be seen from Prescott and Prescott Valley but not expect anything more than light smoke or haze in the region.

Tomorrow, winds will weaken but still move any smoke that is produced toward the northeast. Once again, only light impacts are expected (if any).
