# Fire


Hermits Peak Fire ~ Calf Canyon Fire combined is currently at 270,447 acres with 30% containment. Low humidity and lighter WSW conditions will be observed today.

## Smoke

All communities in the outlook area may experience increased smoke today with lighter winds and stable atmospheric conditions. Light NNW winds are forecast to develop overnight, which may cause smoke to accumulate in the outlook area. Daytime winds will shift to the WSW but will be lighter than midweek. Western highlands communities should experience USG and Unhealthy conditions in the morning with modest improvement for periods in the afternoon. The Las Vegas Valley will average USG through most of the day. Mora will experience Unhealthy AQ this morning and USG this afternoon. Rociada, Pendaries, and Buena Vista should experience USG conditions throughout the outlook period. Forecasts remain dependent on possibility of new fire growth.
