## Fire


Hermits Peak Fire  $\sim$  Calf Canyon Fire combined is currently at 306,472 acres with 40% containment.

### Smoke

A backdoor cold front is forecast to push across the outlook area this afternoon into evening. This will bring easterly winds, cooler temperatures, and higher humidities to the region with the frontal passage. Model guidance has smoke pushing west into the Penasco and Taos areas by evening into the overnight hours and cleaning out by late morning as winds return to a more southwesterly direction. Models also suggest with the increase in humidites and lower temperatures there is potential for the formation of fog in the western portions of Colfax, Mora, San Miguel counties along with eastern Taos County. Caution is advised in the early morning hours Sunday due to possibility areas of smoke may interact with fog to create poor visibility on roadways. Overall air quality conditions are expected to be Good to Moderate through the afternoon across the outlook area.

## **Air Quality Alert**

An Air Quality Alert is in effect for the region through 1 PM Sunday. Counties in the outlook area include: Taos, Colfax, Mora, and San Miguel counties.
