## Eastern New Mexico - Hermits Peak & Calf Canyon Fires

6/07 - 6/08

### Special Statement

A FLASH FLOOD WATCH has been issued for the area of the fire, starting tomorrow at noon through 10pm.

### Fire

Hermits Peak & Calf Canyon Fire is currently at 317,920 acres and 65% contained.

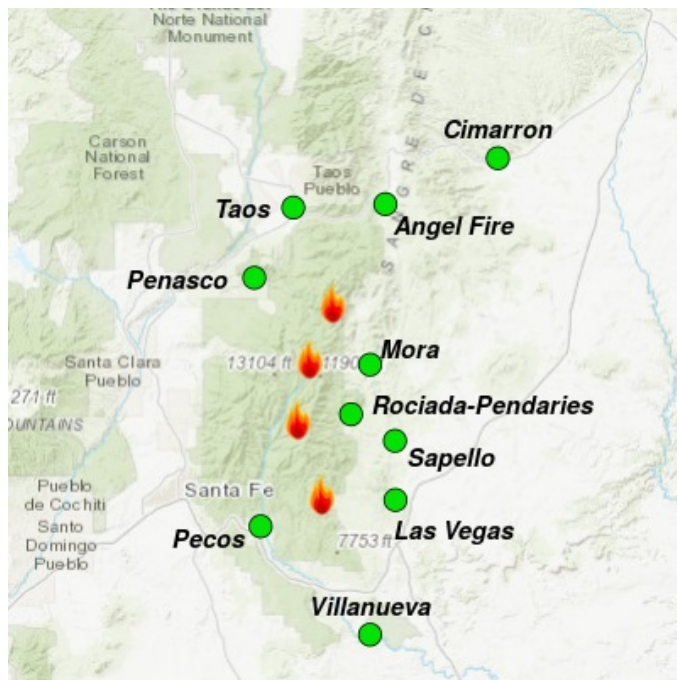
### Smoke

We can expect 'Good' air quality across the outlook area again today. Interior pockets of fuel are continuing to burn and smolder, producing visible smoke in some areas. However, it's generally not impacting air quality.

Weather changes are coming, starting today with an increase in humidity and chance for dry thunderstorms. Gusty, erratic winds ahead of a storm could move smoke into any direction. Tomorrow, isolated thunderstorms could produce locally heavy rain. Flash flooding is a concern should one of these storms line up with a burn scar. Stay alert to changing conditions!

Air Quality Index (AQI)	Actions to Protect Yourself
