## **San Miguel/ Mora County News Release Calf Canyon/ Hermits Peak Fire**

### **Flood Advisory**

**Las Vegas** – The National Weather Service in Albuquerque has issued a Flood Advisory for Portions of north central and northeast New Mexico, including the following counties, in north central New Mexico, Rio Arriba and Santa Fe. In northeast New Mexico, Mora, and San Miguel.

- \* WHAT... Arroyo and small stream flooding caused by excessive rainfall is expected.
  - \* WHERE... A portion of northeast New Mexico, including the following county, San Miguel.
  - \* WHEN... Until 5:30 PM MDT.
  - \* IMPACTS... Minor flooding in low-lying and poor drainage areas.
  - \* ADDITIONAL DETAILS... At 326 PM MDT, Doppler radar indicated heavy rain due to thunderstorms moving toward the northeast. This will cause arroyo and small stream flooding. Between 0.75 and 1.25 inches of rain have fallen.
- Additional rainfall amounts of 0.5 to 1 inch are expected over the area. This additional rain will result in minor flooding.
- Some locations that will experience flooding include Cowles.
- This includes the following: State Road 63 between Mile Markers 21 and 25.
