**HOG TROUGH FIRE AREA CLOSURE**

**PROHIBITIONS**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following is prohibited on the National Forest System (NFS) lands, roads, trails in the Pintler Ranger District, Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest, described below and shown on the attached map incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A (the "Described Area"):

Going into or being upon the area described below. 36 C.F.R. § 261.53 (e).

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting resource in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a Forest Service special use authorization or other authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.

**DESCRIBED AREA/ROADS/TRAILS**

The Described Area is all NFS lands, roads and trails within the boundary starting in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 29 in T5N R16W at the junction of FS Trail 8017 and FS Road 78568; then continuing south to the junction of FS Trail 8019 and FS Road 5072 in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 6 in T4N R16W; then following FS Trail 8019 in a southwest direction to the south and east of trail 8019 to the Forest Boundary in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 1 in T3N R18W; then following the Forest Boundary to the west in Section 2 in T3N R18W and continuing along the Forest Boundary to the north to the junction of FS Trail 313 and the Forest Boundary in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30 in T6N R17W; then following in a south east direction, south of HWY 38, to the repeater site in the NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8 in T5N R16W; then following south to Mt. Emerine; then following south/southeast to the starting point in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 29 in T5N R16W.

## PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is to ensure public health and safety during fire suppression efforts of the Hog Trough Fire.

## IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order shall be in effect from July 22, 2022 at 0600 until rescinded or until October 31, 2022 at 0001, whichever occurs first.


Unless otherwise expressly defined in this Order, the terms used in this Order are defined by the regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299. If there are terms in this Order that are not expressly defined in the Order or 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299, their meaning shall be determined by their plain language definitions.

A violation of the above prohibitions is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.
