CURRENT SITUATION

Situation Summary:

Suppression repair continues throughout the fire area. Minimal fire was observed overnight. Containment continues to rise. The fire is holding within control lines. Fire crews continue to mop up hot spots and do tactical patrols throughout the fire area. On the northeast side of the fire, crews continue working to increase containment and strengthen control lines. Unpopulated areas of the fire remain closed. Excess resources will continue to be released.

PG&E Oak Fire Event Update:

On Wednesday, August 3rd at 1430 hours PG&E restored the remaining 224 customers that had been impacted by the Oak fire. In the past six days, the PG&E crews were able to safely replaced 207 utility poles and associated equipment and restrung 6.87 miles of conductor.
