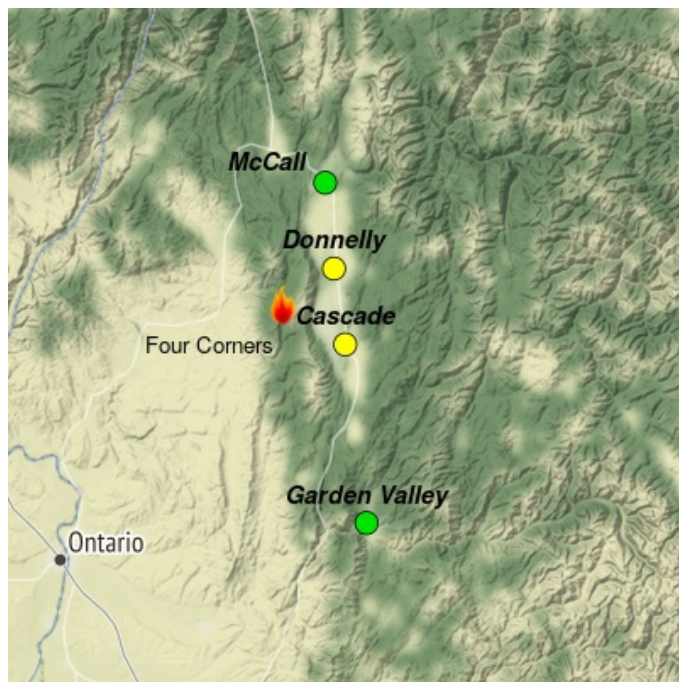

Fire

The fire is currently at 8208 acres with 11% containment along its northwest perimeter. More active fire behavior is expected today with lower humidity, and more unstable and breezy conditions than the previous few days. Smoke

MODERATE to UNHEALTHY for SENSITIVE GROUPS (USG) air quality is expected from Donnelly to Cascade. Mostly GOOD conditions are expected elsewhere across the Outlook region. However, outflow winds from isolated thunderstorms could help to disperse smoke later in the day.
