

Fire

The Ammon continues to have no significant activity, as fuels interior continue to smolder. Interior pockets of unburned fuel on the Campbell Fire will continue to burn. Firefighters will continue to conduct firing operations near Hawkins Creek when favorable. With stable weather conditions over the fire area, fire activity is expected to be active again today. The Six Rivers Lightning Complex fire is now 37,081 acres, after growing 2,719 acres yesterday. The fire complex is at 64% contained.

Smoke

Once again, the morning inversion will cause smoke to come West into Willow Creek and communities North along the Trinity River from late morning to late afternoon. These areas and Burnt Ranch may see periods of VERY UNHEALTHY to possibly HAZARDOUS air quality again throughout the middle of the day. West winds in the afternoon will move smoke towards Weaverville and may possibly settle into the area overnight.
