Fire

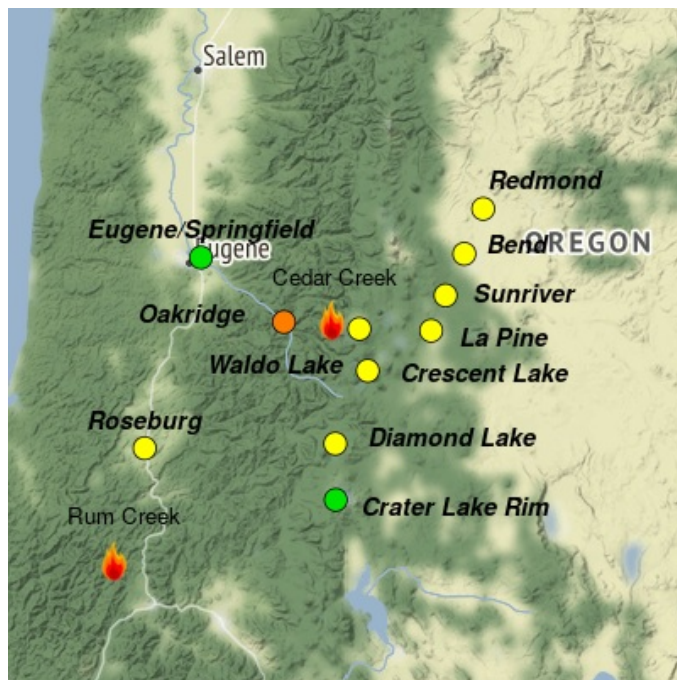
The Cedar Creek Fire in Central Oregon is 8,817 acres with 12% containment. We are expecting active fire today with light winds and hot, dry air over the area. For additional information on the fires, see [Cedar Creek Fire](#), and [Rum Creek Fire](#)

Smoke

The entire forecast area will have some smoke impacts all day from not only the Cedar Creek Fire but also the Rum Creek fire burning to our southwest. Oakridge will have USG (unhealthy for sensitive groups) to Unhealthy levels of smoke for most of the day. Waldo Lake will see Moderate to possibly USG levels of smoke this afternoon.

Air Quality Index (AQI)	Actions to Protect Yourself
[Green circle] Good	None
[Yellow circle] Moderate	Unusually sensitive individuals should consider limiting prolonged or heavy exertion.
[Orange circle] USG	People within Sensitive Groups* should reduce prolonged or heavy outdoor exertion.
[Red circle] Unhealthy	People within Sensitive Groups* should avoid all physical outdoor activity.
[Purple circle] Very Unhealthy	Everyone should avoid prolonged or heavy exertion.
[Dark red circle] Hazardous	Everyone should avoid any outdoor activity.

***Disclaimer:** This forecast is based on fine particulates only; ozone is not included. Forecasts may be wrong; use at own risk. Use caution as conditions can change quickly. See your health professional as needed. Smoke sensitive groups should take appropriate precautions.
