Fire



Smoke


Areas east of the Cedar Creek fire will have the greatest smoke impacts today with La Pine, Sunriver and Bend in the unhealthy range this morning. Oakridge will have good air quality today, but smoke impacts will increase tonight. Waldo Lake will see unhealthy to USG levels of smoke today through tomorrow.
