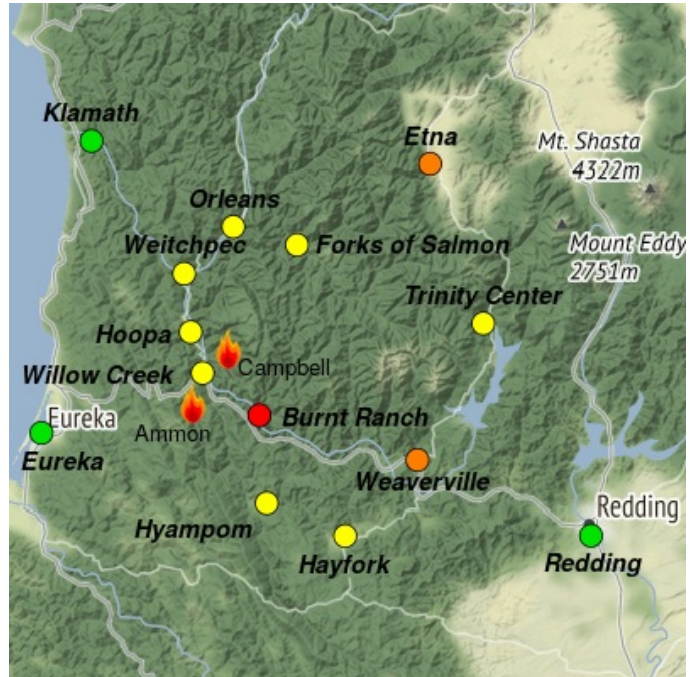

Fire

The Campbell fire did not see any additional fire perimeter growth yesterday. Interior areas of unburned fuel will continue to burn and produce smoke, especially with the afternoon heat. Today, firefighters continue to mop-up and secure the fire's edge. The Ammon Fire is 100% contained. The Six Rivers Lightning Complex fire is now 40,995 acres, after growing 227 acres yesterday. The fire complex is at 63% contained.

Smoke

With the fire perimeter holding steady, smoke production decreased yesterday, and air quality conditions improved. Similar air quality conditions can be expected today. The morning inversion will again concentrate smoke along the Trinity River. Once it lifts in the mid-afternoon smoke will clear from the area. The Mountain Fire may continue to impact communities in Scott Valley throughout the day and Trinity Center and Weaverville overnight.
