### Fire

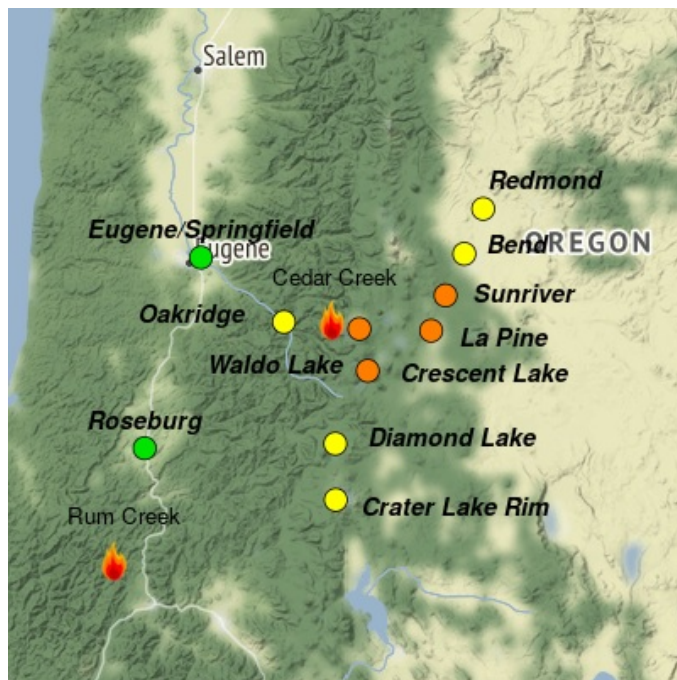
The Cedar Creek Fire in Central Oregon is 17,625 acres with 12% containment. The fire grew 910 acres yesterday. We are expecting moderate to active fire activity today, with slightly warmer temperatures and lower relative humidity values. ### Smoke

Areas east of the Cedar Creek fire will continue to have the greatest smoke impacts today with La Pine, Sunriver and Bend in the moderate to USG range. Oakridge will have some increase in smoke impacts today with moderate to occasional USG. Easterly flow will bring increasing smoke to Eugene/Springfield early on Tuesday. Expect USG conditions in the morning, improving to moderate in the afternoon.

Eugene/Springfield			Good air quality today into this evening. Smoke increasing overnight.			
Roseburg			Good air quality today with some increase in light smoke tonight.

Air Quality Index (AQI)	Actions to Protect Yourself
Good	None
Moderate	Unusually sensitive individuals should consider limiting prolonged or heavy exertion.
USG	People within Sensitive Groups* should <b>reduce</b> prolonged or heavy outdoor exertion.
Unhealthy	People within Sensitive Groups* should <b>avoid all</b> physical outdoor activity.
Very Unhealthy	Everyone should avoid prolonged or heavy exertion.
Hazardous	Everyone should avoid any outdoor activity.
