Fire

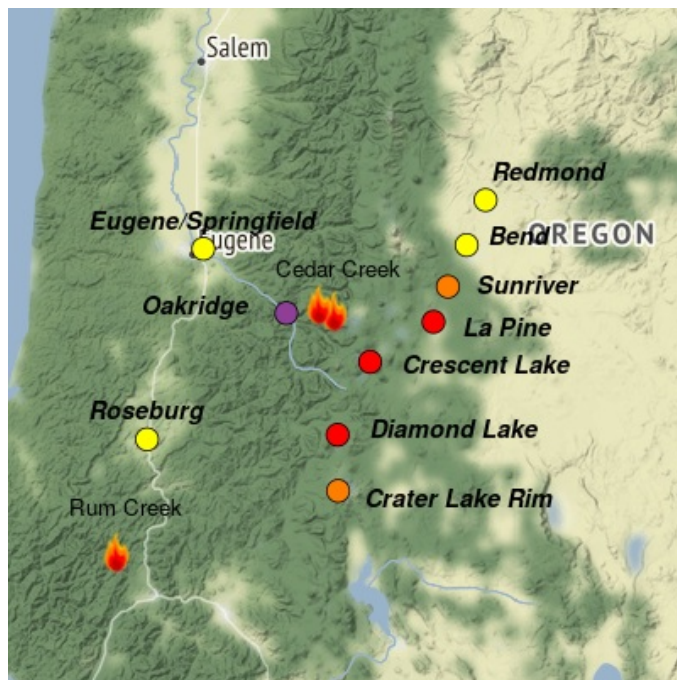
The Cedar Creek Fire in Central Oregon is 85,926 acres with 12% containment. The fire grew 34,112 acres over the past 24 hours. We are expecting moderate to active fire activity today with cooler temperatures and higher relative humidity values.

Smoke

Areas near and to the east of the Cedar Creek fire will have the greatest impacts today, including Oakridge and Sunriver down to the Crater Lake rim. Oakridge currently is experiencing hazardous air quality and expect Unhealthy to very unhealthy conditions to prevail through the day. Areas to the west and southwest will experience moderate air quality.

Health and Safety Message

Watch for periods of better air quality during the afternoons to run errands or be active outside. But check your local monitor and follow advice in the AQI table below when air quality is impaired. Air Quality Index (AQI)	Actions to Protect Yourself
Good	None
Moderate	Unusually sensitive individuals should consider limiting prolonged or heavy exertion.
USG	People within Sensitive Groups* should reduce prolonged or heavy outdoor exertion.
Unhealthy	People within Sensitive Groups* should avoid all physical outdoor activity.
Very Unhealthy	Everyone should avoid prolonged or heavy exertion.
Hazardous	Everyone should avoid any outdoor activity.
