

FOREST ORDER NO. 05-04-54-23-15  
USDA FOREST SERVICE  
INYO NATIONAL FOREST  
SEVEN PINES RECREATIONAL RESIDENT TRACT CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Inyo National Forest. This Order is effective from June 28, 2023, through July 15, 2023 (subject to runoff and site review).

1. Occupying recreation residence cabins located within the Seven Pines Recreation Resident Tract Closure Area, as described in Exhibit A, and shown on Exhibit B. 36 C.F.R. § 261.58(b).
2. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Seven Pines Resident Tract Closure Area, as described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B. 36 C.F.R. § 261.53(e).

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions contained in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A. A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.

EXHIBIT A

The boundary of the Seven Pines Recreation Residence Tract Closure Area begins at the intersection of FS Road 13S17C/Seven Pines Tract Road and FS Road 13S17/Onion Valley Road [landmark A] and continues northeast along Onion Valley Road at 300° for 1274 ft [landmark B], changing to 338° along Onion Valley Road for an additional 1056 ft to where it crosses Independence Creek [landmark C] , changing to 25° for 623 ft [landmark D], changing to 111° for 1904 ft [Landmark E] and changing to 227° for 1504 ft back to the starting point [Landmark A].
