An **Air Quality Advisory** has been issued for parts of Lane and Deschutes County that remains in effect until midday Tuesday, August 1.

Fire


The Bedrock Fire is currently estimated at 9,568 acres and has no containment at this time. Increased humidity, light winds, and cloud cover have resulted in some decrease in fire activity and smoke production. While similar conditions are expected for Sunday we may see some increase on Monday and Tuesday with drier air.

Smoke

Smoke impacts this morning are improved compared to prior days with generally Moderate to USG Air Quality Index (AQI) along Highway 97 from Redmond through La Pine although some pockets of heavier smoke may be present. Moderate AQI conditions are expected along the McKenzie Road corridor from Blue River to Sisters for much of today. Expect best air quality for most locations this afternoon with Good-Moderate AQI before smoke returns by late afternoon and continues into the overnight, especially for the Highway 97 corridor where Moderate to Unhealthy AQI can be expected. Elsewhere, look for little to no surface smoke today with Good to Moderate AQI although haze will likely continue to be present. A fairly persistent weather pattern will lead to similar air quality conditions for upcoming few days.
