Summary: The Hayden Fire started on Wednesday, July 19th, 2023, at approximately 11:30 am. The fire is located in the Lemhi Range, 18 miles west of Leadore, Idaho. The Hayden Fire is a full suppression fire. Firefighters are working long hours every day to contain the fire as quickly as they can, impacting the fewest acres possible.

Weather: THERE IS A RED FLAG WARNING FOR GUSTY WINDS AND LOW RELATIVE HUMIDITY. Southwesterly winds with gusts up to 40 mph will pick up over the fire today. With poor humidity recoveries overnight and windy conditions predicted to continue the next few days, expect critical fire weather.

Actions: Yesterday, increased cloud cover played a significant role in moderating fire behavior and crews made good progress on connecting and strengthening primary control lines in the eastern portion of the fire. The dozer line on the eastern edge of the fire was completed. Near Kadletz Creek, crews experienced short wind-driven runs, but all fire remains within primary containment lines. Last night, on the eastern edge of the fire, taking advantage of the cool night air, fire was introduced to pockets of unburned fuel to reduce the chance of group tree torching and spotting over control lines.
