Central Idaho - Salmon Challis Hayden Fire


Fire

The Elk Horn Fire increased activit, added an estimated 5,000 acres in the last 24-hours. The Hayden Fire continues to see Red Flag conditions, with wind, low humidity, and warm temperatures. Gusty erratic winds will increase fire behavior along the southern flank where winds align with terrain. Elsewhere, moderated fire behavior is expected. Containment has been updated to 5% and will increase as suppression efforts anchor lines using the Tobias (2033) burn scar and rocky features to prevent spread into lighter fuels at lower elevations. Tuesday into Wednesday, weather begins to shift with more cloud cover, lower high temperatures, and higher humidity. This weather shift will dampen fire behavior, allowing smoldering and creeping to consume interior fuels.

Smoke

The Elk Horn Fire is impacting North Fork, Carmen, and Salmon. Daytime smoke will move north-northeast over the Bitterroot Range; disperse smoke will settle along the Middle Fork of the Salmon River into North Fork and Salmon overnight. Hayden smoke impacts will concentrate in the immediate vicinity of the fire along Hayden Creek and associated drainages. Communities from Hayden Creek to HWY 28, will experience heavy smoke overnight into late morning. By afternoon and evening, conditions improve with light-to-moderate smoke from noon til nightfall. Impacts to Lemhi, Tendoy, Baker, and up to Salmon, will follow a similar pattern: good from midday til dusk, slowly building overnight with heaviest smoke from midnight til midday. Weather shifts by Wednesday will clear out residual smoke with wetting rain.
