TEMPORARY CLOSURE ORDER COS06-23-01
BLM managed land between Cunningham Gulch to Mill Creek Road (County Rd 727)
BLM Lands, Section 11, Section 12, Section 13, Section 14, T.51 N., R2 W

Under authority of the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976 (Title 43, United States Code, Section 1701, et. seq.) pursuant to Title 43, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 9212.1(g), the following temporary closure is in effect within all BLM-managed lands lying between Cunningham Gulch on the south to Mill Creek Road (Gunnison County Road 727) on the north to all public use to provide for public safety during a wildfire incident in Gunnison County, Colorado.

Exemptions:

Pursuant to Title 43 CFR Section 9212.2, the following persons are exempt from this order:

- Any federal, state, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- Persons with a BLM-issued permit specifically authorizing an otherwise prohibited act.

Penalties:

Pursuant to Title 43 CFR Section 9212.4, any person who knowingly and willfully violates the regulations of Section 9212.1 of this title shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not more than \$1,000 or to imprisonment of not more than twelve months, or both. Restitution for total suppression or damage costs incurred will be borne by the violator.
