

**MENDOCINO NATIONAL FOREST

FOREST ORDER NO. 08-23-06
SLIDE FIRE AREA, TRAIL, ROAD, AND RECREATION SITE CLOSURE**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a) and (b) and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Mendocino National Forest. This Order is effective from August 18, 2023, through April 1, 2024.

- 1) Going into or being upon the portion of the Yolla Bolly - Middle Eel Wilderness Area located within the Grindstone Ranger District, as shown on Exhibit A. 36 C.F.R. § 261.52(e).
- 2) Entering or using the following recreation sites or portions thereof:
 - a) Ides Cove Backpacker Trailhead
 - b) Ides Cove Horsepacker Trailhead36 C.F.R. § 261.58(b).
- 3) Being on any of the following National Forest System Trails, as shown on Exhibit A:
 - a) 9W01
 - b) 9W03
 - c) 9W04
 - d) 9W51
 - e) 9W54
 - f) 9W80
 - g) 10W09
 - h) 10W93
 - i) 10W9136 C.F.R. § 261.55(a).
- 4) Being on any of the following National Forest System roads, as shown in Exhibit A:
 - a) 25N14
 - b) 25N24
 - c) 25N19
 - d) 25N19A
 - e) 25N19C
 - f) 25N21
 - g) 25N21C36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e).


Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire-fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions contained in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571 and 3581.
