Smoke

Northwest winds are shifting to the west and changing recent air quality patterns.

Smoke from the Bedrock and Salmon fires is expected for Oakridge and southeast along Highway 58 this morning with impacts peaking at UNHEALTHY levels near midday. Eastward, on the Highway 97 corridor encompassing La Pine, Bend, Redmond, Prineville and Madras, smoke is expected with periods of MODERATE air quality possible for most areas. La Pine will likely see the most significant smoke impacts this evening with USG conditions developing. On the McKenzie River Highway corridor from Vida through to Sisters, MODERATE conditions are likely near midday. Lowell, Springfield, and Eugene may experience a period of light smoke this morning, but it should clear leaving GOOD conditions today.

Similar smoke conditions are expected to continue for much of the remaining work week with consistent westerly winds.
