### Smoke

The Lookout, Wylie, Salmon, and the Bedrock fires in this outlook area will continue to impact air quality.

Eugene/Springfield area, Detroit Lake, and Madras should experience GOOD overall air quality again today. McKenzie through to Sisters and Prineville are likely to experience smoke this morning through the afternoon with MODERATE to USG conditions overall. Bend is expected to have USG conditions all day and overnight. La Pine is expected to experience USG to UNHEALTHY conditions for most of the day, continuing into the area overnight. Oakridge and eastward on Highway 58 is predicted to have USG to UNHEALTHY conditions late morning through the early evening.

Conditions will moderate Sunday in the Prineville, Redmond and Bend Areas, as the smoke is pushed more to the southwest. La Pine and Oakridge will likely continue to experience smoke in USG levels.
