

Smoke Outlook North Cascades Sourdough

8/27 - 8/28

Issued by Wildland Fire Air Quality Response Program on August 27, 2023 at 08:06 AM PDT

Fire

Acreage stands at 6,138 acres, with 25% containment. Hot, dry conditions leading to increased fire behavior today. For more fire information, see: Inciweb

Smoke

Hot and dry conditions will result in increased smoke production from multiple fires in the Cascade Range including the Sourdough Fire. Smoke from fires in Oregon will be transported into the area east of the cascades but will mostly remain above the surface. This coupled with light variable winds in the forecast area will lead to hazy skies especially east of the cascades, with mostly MODERATE conditions with some periods of USG from Seattle to Bellingham. Communities in close proximity to any of the fires can expect concentrations to reach UNHEALTHY or above at times due to terrain driven winds. Communities west of the cascades should see more clear skies and MODERATE conditions. Widespread rain is expected across the forecast area on Tuesday which will provide smoke relief area wide.

Heat Advisory

Heat advisory continues to 8 PM PDT today for hot conditions. This will pose a moderate risk of heat-related illness. For more information about smoke, heat and your health, visit: Department of Health
