## Fire

The Elkhorn Fire encompasses 26,048 acres and is 74% complete (visit Inciweb-Elkhorn for more details). The extensive rain across the region has reduced the fire's strength. It continues to smolder within dead and downed timber. Fortunately, we do not expect the fire to spread.

## Smoke

In the morning, downstream of the fire, the Salmon River basin should experience minimal smoke. However, there is a chance that smoke from the East Fire near Cascades, Idaho, might affect McCall. Conversely, Grangeville, Elk City, and Salmon are expected to have little to no smoke impact. Hamilton, MT, is also anticipated to have minimal to no influence from smoke.
