Fire


The Bedrock fire is estimated at 12,213 total acres and is 5% contained. No acreage update was available due to weather. Active fire is expected to continue as fuels dry even with the absence of strong winds.

Smoke

A chance of showers in the area may lead to fluctuating wind and smoke patterns. Remain alert for changing conditions.

Oakridge area will see heavier smoke in the afternoon before slowly clearing the area by this evening. A return to the northwest winds will bring smoke back along the Hwy 58 corridor and into La Pine for the late afternoon and into the overnight. The McKenzie corridor may see smoke and MODERATE conditions in the afternoon but should remain GOOD overall.

The Eugene/Springfield area will experience some periods of MODERATE this morning as smoke from the Priceboro Fire impacts the area, but overall air quality should remain GOOD.
