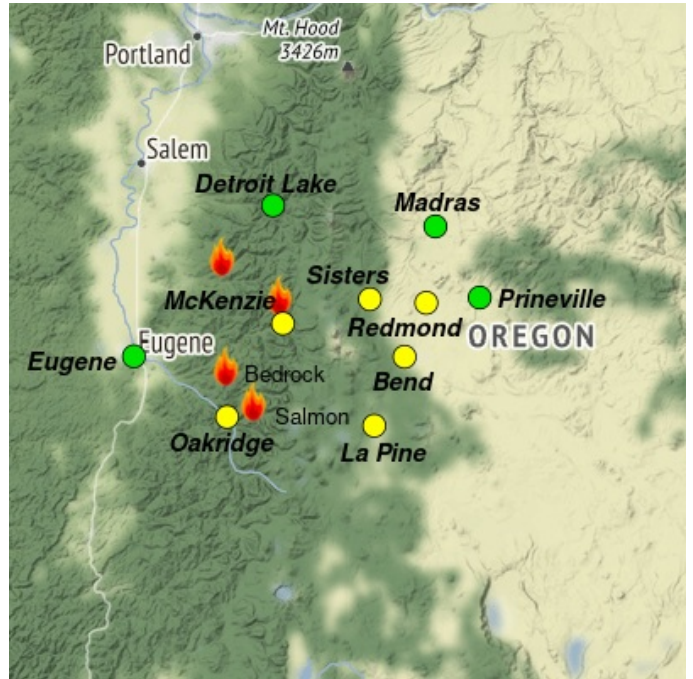

Smoke

Smoke from Salmon, Lookout, Wylie, and the Bedrock fire in the outlook area will continue to impact air quality.

Detroit Lake and Madras will remain GOOD although some light smoke or haze may be seen. Eugene, Springfield, and other locations such as Lowell may see light smoke but remain GOOD overall. Oakridge and Highway 58 east of Oakridge are likely to experience smoke this morning into the mid-afternoon with up to UNHEALTHY conditions before clearing. The McKenzie corridor will likely see smoke at times from the Bedrock and Lookout fires with GOOD to MODERATE conditions. East of the Cascades will see smoke at times with brief USG conditions possible and otherwise MODERATE overall for many locations with the exception of Prineville which should see only brief impacts. A similar pattern is expected for Thursday and Friday which lead to similar air quality impacts throughout the area.

Air Quality Index (AQI)	Actions to Protect Yourself
● Good	None
● Moderate	Unusually sensitive individuals should consider limiting prolonged or heavy exertion.
● USG	People within Sensitive Groups* should reduce prolonged or heavy outdoor exertion.
● Unhealthy	People within Sensitive Groups* should avoid all physical outdoor activity.
● Very Unhealthy	Everyone should avoid prolonged or heavy exertion.
● Hazardous	Everyone should avoid any outdoor activity.
