Fire

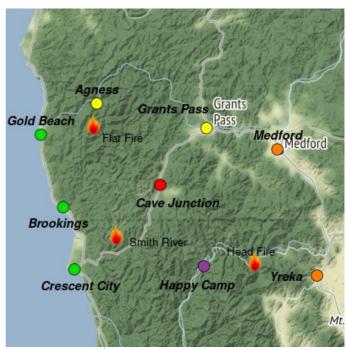
The Flat Fire has burned 33,895 acres with containment at 58%. Fire activity is minimal. ... Across N CA, numerous fires have developed, including the Smith River Fire Complex and the Head Fire. Smoke

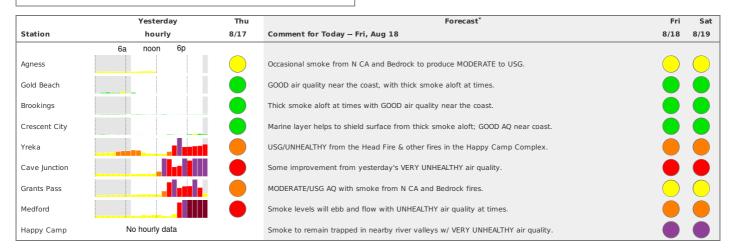
AQ impacts will be mostly from the N CA fires. UNHEALTHY to HAZARDOUS conditions have been observed from the Klamath up to Medford. Locations in OR will improve later Friday, but smoke will remain trapped in the valleys downwind of the Smith River and Head Fires. These valleys will see VERY UNHEALTHY and some HAZARDOUS; Yreka and Cave Junction will see UNHEALTHY to VERY UNHEALTHY. USG is expected for Medford. As this is a rapidly changing situation, see the links at the bottom for the latest updates.

Road Closure

In California, US-199 is closed from Pioneer Rd to the Agricultural Inspection Station due to fire activity.
