Flathead Valley Big Knife, Niarada and Additional Fires

Fire


The Big Knife, Niarada, and Mill Pocket Fires had continued cooler temperatures and some moisture yesterday, keeping fire activity moderated. Warmer, drier weather returns today along with increased winds this afternoon. This weather will dry fuels so fire activity is expected to increase today and tomorrow. If conditions and visibility allow, strategic burnout operations may be conducted to establish or strengthen containment lines.

Smoke

Generally GOOD to MODERATE air quality is expected throughout the forecast area today as recent cooler weather and higher humidity have reduced fire activity. Elmo, Kalispell and Columbia Falls will experience heaviest smoke levels in the morning. That smoke is expected to travel north and east, affecting West Glacier in the afternoon. Higher winds and warmer temperatures are expected to increase fire activity and smoke production today and tomorrow, but the winds may also help with clearing the smoke. As the winds die down, expect that increased smoke may return to the Valley in coming days.
