The Lookout Fire is 18,888 acres and is 16% contained. Information for the fire can be found at inciweb.nwcg.gov.

Smoke

Highest smoke impacts from the Lookout Fire remain for the McKenzie River drainage and Blue River due to its close proximity to the fire. Air Quality should reach HAZARDOUS levels again in the drainage midday before improving slightly in the evening. Smoke that drifted into the Willamette Valley from fires in NW California as well as the Lookout fire is slowly lessening, yet periods of UNHEALTHY FOR SENSITIVE GROUPS are expected midday. Central Oregon will continue to see generally MODERATE conditions until Sunday night into Monday when an increase in westerly winds look to drift smoke back to the east.


NOTE: There is the potential of additional smoke impacts in the region due to new fire starts from Thursday night's thunderstorm activity.
