
### Special Statement Lowline Fire

# Fire

The Lowline wildfire is at 1,871 acres and 55% containment.

## Smoke

With current weather systems moving into the area we will see GOOD air quality in the forecast today. Some light smoke in the central Gunnison early a.m. as weather / wind push some smoke into the area drainages. Rain will continue in the area over the weekend keeping smoke very minimal in and around Gunnison. Almont and HWY 135 east of the fire will have GOOD air quality today as west winds increase and low fire activity continues. Crested Butte will continue to see GOOD air quality throughout the weekend.
