Smoke

Smoke has settled into High Prairie, Oakridge, La Pine, Bend, and even Redmond areas this morning with at least MODERATE air quality, much of this should improve after midday. Look for periods of MODERATE conditions along parts of the McKenzie area this afternoon. Periods of MODERATE will be expected for many locations south and east of the fire for areas along Hwy 58 from Oakridge southeast, and also towards the Hwy 97 corridor, especially La Pine and Crescent as smoke from today is transported away from the fire.

The new Salmon Fire located east of Oakridge will bring additional smoke into the Oakridge and Highway 58 corridor with periods of at least USG being possible.
