
The Lowline wildfire is currently at 1,871 acres and 55% containment.

Smoke in the valley and areas of Gunnison and Central Gunnison County continue into early morning and late evenings with MODERATE smoke impacts. Smoke will clear out by mid-day with increasing west winds in the area. County Road #730 area will continue to see periods of MODERATE smoke.
