
Fire

Numerous wildfires are burning throughout the Greater NW California region, including many that are in extremely rugged, complex terrain with limited access. Within the outlook area the **Happy Camp Complex**, **Six Rivers NF Lightning Complex**, and **Deep Fire** are the largest and will continue to impact air quality. 
Smoke

Key Messages: (1) Broad improvement in AQ for eastern portions of the area today, particularly locations not near the larger fires. (2) Only slight improvement if any for the Hoopa Valley, Klamath Valley corridor and NW valleys; however, widespread UNHEALTHY to VERY UNHEALTHY conditions likely to persist.

A more favorable fire environment forecast across the eastern two-thirds of the outlook area in near-term owing to cloud cover, cooler temperatures/higher humidity, and increased wetting rainfall coverage. Steadier and heavier rainfall will generally remain east of the largest fires/complexes and only modest decreases if any in fire danger are anticipated for the far west and northwest portions of the area to include Willow Creek, Hoopa, and the Klamath River Valley. Cautiously optimistic for improved dispersion Tuesday late morning into the afternoon, but any improvement will be brief as a significant clearing event is not expected at this time.
