## Northwest California-Interior Happy Camp Complex



## Fire

Firefighters continue building fire lines across the west and north flanks of the Head Fire, near the community of Hamburg, and improving the existing fire line on the east side. On the Scott Fire, pockets of vegetation within the interior will continue to burn. The complex has burned approximately 22,195 acres. Winds will continue to shift toward to south/southeast through the afternoon associated with a weak frontal passage. ## Smoke

Last night transport winds shifted out of the NW/N. While smoke will not be fully scrubbed from the NW valleys today, there's good potential for at least widespread improvement for many locations in the northwest area of this outlook. This "cleaning event" will be pushing smoke to the South/Southeast degrading then improving conditions for Scott/Shasta Valleys. Active fires to the W/NW of the Complex will contribute smoke to western portions of the area, but there should be a brief reprieve to the air quality conditions this afternoon into the evening. **Precipitation events are anticipated late in the week. Trend toward moderate to good dispersion that will likely improve overall smoke conditions for most areas.**
