

## Smoke Outlook Salmon-Challis Idaho Elkhorn Fire

8/23 - 8/24



## Fire

The Elkhorn Fire encompasses 26,048 acres and is 74% complete (visit Inciweb-Elkhorn for more details). The abundant rainfall in the area has weakened the fire's intensity, and there is no anticipation of further fire spread.

## Smoke

Today smoke from fires in Northern California, Oregon and some in Washington will impact central Idaho. In the morning, Grangeville will experience smoke in the UNHEALTHY range, however it should reduce to USG and MODERATE for the rest of the day and continue to improve over the next few days. Elk City and the Salmon River basin north of McCall should experience some smoke through Thursday. Hamilton, MT, may have MODERATE levels of smoke this evening and through Thursday.
