Fire

Acreage stands at 6,138 acres. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, creeping and flanking. Containment is 25%. For more fire information, see: Inciweb

Smoke

Fire behavior expected to increase today and throughout the weekend with hot and dry conditions over the fire. This will result in increased smoke production from multiple fires in the Cascade Range including the Sourdough Fire. Communities in close proximity to any of the fires can expect concentrations to reach UNHEALTHY or above at times due to terrain driven winds. An easterly flow is forecasted to persist through Monday which is pushing smoke toward the Puget Sound, impacting Seattle and Bellingham areas. Rain expected across the forecast area on Tuesday which will provide smoke relief west and east of The Cascades.

Heat Advisory
