Fire

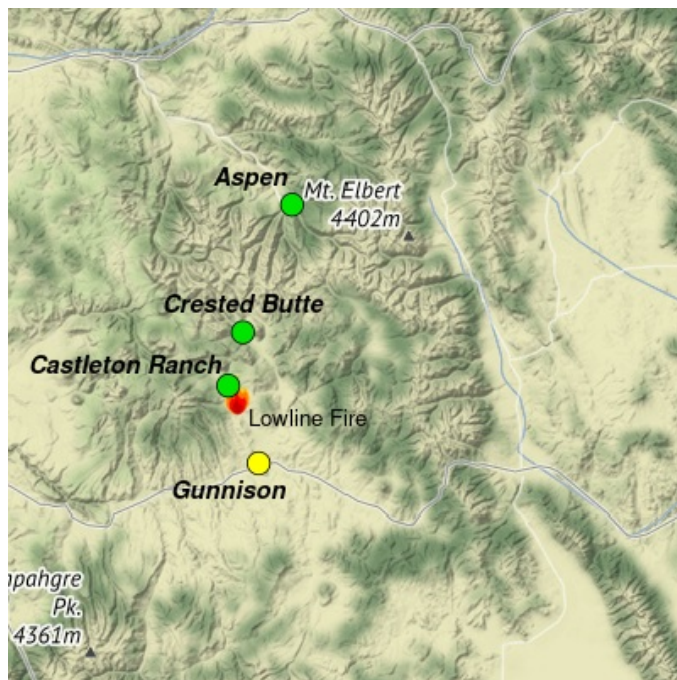
The Lowline wildfire is currently at 1,814 acres and 55% containment.

Smoke

Decreased fire activity, cooler temperatures, and past precipitation in the area we will see MODERATE - GOOD air quality Saturday morning in Gunnison. Early a.m. light periods of MODERATE smoke possible in areas around Gunnison County. Castleton area along County Road #730 will see GOOD air quality today in the area, with some possible MODERATE smoke at times if fire activity increases. Crested Butte will see GOOD air quality in the area for the weekend. Aspen will continue to see GOOD air quality throughout the weekend.

Unhealthy	People within Sensitive Groups* should avoid all physical outdoor activity.
Very Unhealthy	Everyone should avoid prolonged or heavy exertion.
Hazardous	Everyone should avoid any outdoor activity.
