
Issued by Wildland Fire Air Quality Response Program on September 10, 2023 at 06:46 AM PDT

Fire

The Tyee Ridge Complex and other fires in the Outlook area have potential to remain active, as crews construct line, attack hotspots, and prepare smaller tactical firing. Successful tactical firing occurred late Saturday along a southern portion of the Cougar fire, and additional smaller operations may occur today. Smoke

Smoke settled in the Garden Valley and northern Roseburg areas late Saturday. Weather forecasts favor higher humidity settling in early this week, so overall smoke activity should be lower through at least Tuesday. Smoke transport from the Tyee Ridge Complex will generally be to the S/SE today and visible smoke/haze between Sutherlin and Canyonville in the Coles, Garden, Flournoy, and Looking Glass valleys is likely this afternoon. Expect generally GOOD conditions in Roseburg this AM before smoke and haze returns in the afternoon/evening bringing periods of MODERATE. Smoke concentrations will be lighter in the Cascades with generally GOOD conditions. Monitor air quality by visiting the Fire and Smoke Map.
