**Overview:** On the evening of August 15, the Six Rivers National Forest and Redwood National and State Parks received 150 lightning strikes across the area spanning almost 1 million acres. After the significant lightning event there were 27 confirmed fires. On Saturday, September 2, 2023, Rocky Mountain Complex Incident Management Team 1 assumed command of 19 fires that remained uncontained within the complex.

The following list contains the fires that are included in the 2023 SRF Lightning Complex and Redwood Lightning Complex. The list will be updated as appropriate:
