Overview: On the evening of August 15, the Six Rivers National Forest and Redwood National and State Parks received 150 lighting strikes across the area spanning almost 1 million acres. After the significant lightning event there were 27 confirmed fires. On Saturday, September 2, 2023, Rocky Mountain Complex Incident Management Team 1 assumed command of 19 fires that remained uncontained within the complex. The Hog Fire was added to the Complex to make a total of 20 fires.
