West-Central Oregon - Lookout and Bedrock Fire

Fire

The Lookout Fire is 25,575 acres with an increase 20% containment. The Bedrock Fire is 31,590 acres with an increase to 85% containment. Latest fire information is available at InciWeb: tinyurl.com/Fire-Information

Smoke

A shift in winds is coming today. We are expected to have a westerly wind flow starting in the late morning followed by chances of thunderstorms into the evening. The clearing of smoke yesterday means that we will likely continue to see GOOD air quality in Central Oregon. Sisters and Madras being downwind of the fire will likely see MODERATE air quality as the west winds pick up. McKenzie, being near the fire will continue to see UNHEALTHY air quality today. The air quality in Detroit Lake and Sweet Home should remain GOOD. Eugene has will continue to see MODERATE air quality for most of the day with air quality improving in the evening hours.
